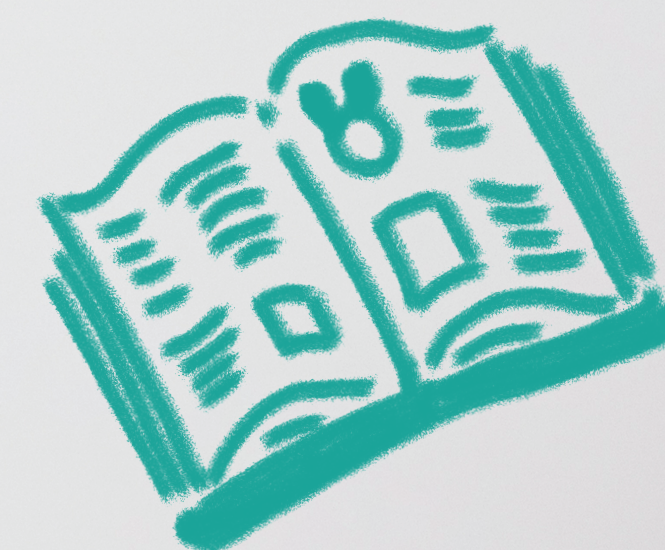
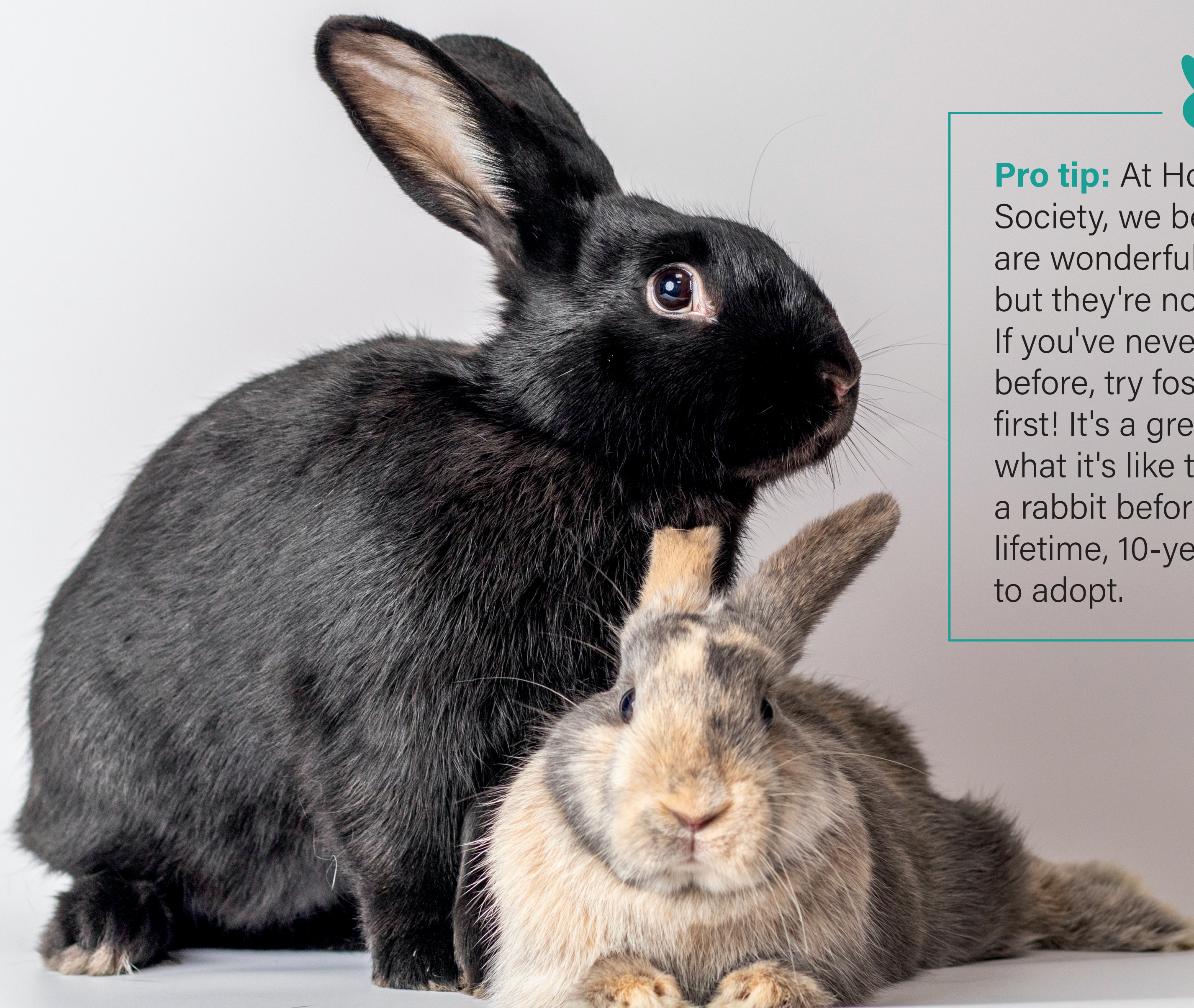


DID YOU KNOW?

- **Smart**—they can learn their name and perform tricks.
- **Quiet**—while rabbits don't make noises like a cat or dog, they have a complex body language that requires commitment to learn.
- **Curious**—they like to explore their surroundings and be part of the action.
- **Frisky**—they love to hop, dance, and zoom.
- **Clean**—they can learn to use a litter box.
- **Energetic** —they need at least 2-4 hours of playtime outside of their pen for physical and mental stimulation, to keep them happy and healthy.
- **Social**—most rabbits prefer having a friend to snuggle and play with.
